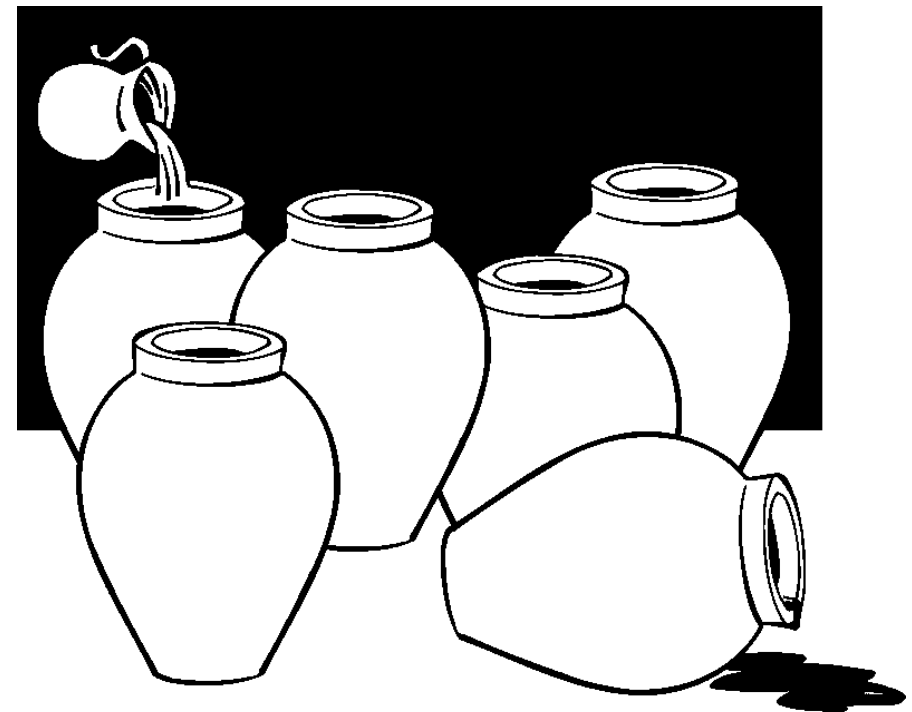

**You will find these words at the beginning of the Baptismal Covenant rite in the United Methodist Hymnal.** We use this each time a person is baptized and when people stand to formally unite with the church and make a profession of faith. For youth, we traditionally call this confirmation. This is the time when youth confirm the vows made on their behalf if they were baptized as infants. For those not baptized as infants, they too confirm their faith as youth and are baptized with the class. **"Youth who are completing the sixth grade shall normally be the youngest people recruited for such preparation." Discipline page 142.**
